

2011 Tecate SCORE Baja 1000 Penalty Information

All finishers must return the tracking device to the IRC post-race area after exiting the finish line. Failure to return the device after you leave the finish line will result in your entry being assigned a DNF. Tracking data will **NOT** be reviewed if the tracking device is not returned in a timely manner. It is the responsibility of the racer to stop at the IRC area and not leave this area until the device is removed.

60 MPH Speed Zone Penalty Information

IRC devices collect approximately 10 data points for every mile of speed zone. A penalty will be assessed for each data point that exceeds 60 MPH. The penalty will be 30 seconds for each MPH that exceeds 60 MPH. The following example of speed data will result in a 24 minute penalty:
56 - 58 - 60 - 59 - 60 - 62 - 63 - 65 - 68 - 70 - 71 - 66 - 63 - 60 - 60 - 59

A competitor who finishes the race with NO DATA or MOSTLY INCOMPLETE DATA will receive the time penalties shown below. It is the responsibility of the racer to ensure that the IRC device is properly installed.

Course Compliance Penalty Information

The data generated from the IRC tracking devices will verify course compliance by providing detailed information for the review of all course deviations.

There are 6 Physical Full Stop Checkpoints.
The penalty for failure to clear a Physical Checkpoint is disqualification.

There are 64 Virtual Checkpoints.
The standard penalty for failure to clear a VCP within 100 feet is 10 minutes.
However, the time penalty will increase as the course deviation distance increases.

Virtual Checkpoint locations are gps waypoints that serve the same purpose as traditional manned physical full stop checkpoints, except vehicles race through these locations without stopping. They are strategically placed to discourage shortcutting. However, the VCPs do not represent the only areas that require compliance. The entire course will be reviewed for compliance.
